Work Description

Operation of excavators, dump trucks, bulldozers, compactors, concrete trucks or other standard construction equipment.

Terms and Conditions

- The named applicant is appointed the prime contractor for WorkSafe BC purposes and now accepts such designation.
- No other construction is allowed during the exempted hours. Vehicle movements must be arranged in order to minimize the sounding of back-up warning devices. Crews are to take appropriate measures to eliminate all unnecessary noise.
- It should be noted that this exception of the Noise Control By-law does not release or alter the applicant's responsibility to obtain all required permits or approvals from other City Departments.
- It is understood that **Wilco Civil Inc.** will notify all residential/hotel accommodations within one block radius 48 hours in advance of the proposed work.
- This permit shall be kept available on the site for presentation to Police Officers or City Inspectors. It is understood that the permit holder will indemnify and save harmless the City of Vancouver from any loss or expense which may arise in consequence of, and here incidental to the granting of this permit.
- **Wilco Civil Inc.** agrees that every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum and that this permit is subject to curtailment or cancellation if reasonable complaints are received.
