

- If the receiver wins a rally, the receiver will score a point. The receiver then becomes the new server.

## DOUBLES

- For double games, the outer side line and back line are in play.
- In doubles the game starts in the right-hand service court. The server alternates courts until service is lost.
- A player on the serving side will serve from the right service court when the serving side has not scored or has scored an even number of points in the game.
- A player of the serving side will serve from the left service court when the serving side has scored an odd number of points in that game.
- The player of the receiving side who served last will stay in the same service court from where he served last. The reverse will apply this to the receiver's partner.
- The player of the receiving side standing in the diagonally opposite service court to the server will be the receiver.
- The players shall not change their respective service courts until they win a point when their side is serving.

## SCORING AND SERVING

- If the serving side wins a rally, the serving side will score a point. The server will then serve again from the alternate service court.
- If the receiving side wins a rally, the receiving side will score a point. The receiving side then becomes the new serving side.
