

GRADUATION TRANSITIONS

The final component of Grad Transitions is the Exit Interview. In order to receive credit for Grad Transitions all components must be completed and submitted to Ms. Marghetti by the **deadlines of:**

January 16th

- Transition Plan with accompanying documents: Resume, Reference Letter & Proof of application to a Post-Secondary

April 5th

- Proof of 30 Hours of Work and/or Volunteer Experience and Reflection Document
- Physical Activity Logs for grades 11 and 12

Students will receive RM (Requirements Met) on their final report card in June. Grad Transitions will not be counted on any Honor roll /Principal's list calculation. It is not considered for admission to Post-Secondary institutions, but **it is a requirement for Graduation.**

STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE ALL PARTS OF THE GRADUATION TRANSITIONS TO GRADUATE.

EXIT INTERVIEW

The exit interview will be conducted at the school by teachers on the morning of **Wednesday, APRIL 5th** (please hand in your final documents to the teacher you have been assigned to for the exit interview). The interviews begins **at 8:30 am**. Each student will be randomly assigned to a teacher. The interviews should last approximately five minutes with the following five questions being asked:

Grade 12 Exit Interview Questions

1. How has your experience in education at Notre Dame helped you develop some of the qualities of a BC Grad?
2. What has your work/ volunteer experience taught you with regard to your overall strengths that will help in your future employment.
3. What type of lifelong plan do you have to maintain a healthy lifestyle that includes physical activity?
4. Setting future goals are always important. What are your immediate and future goals?
5. What have you learned particularly in Christian Education regarding social responsibility?
