

Halloween - 2020

Please note the following regarding wearing costumes on Friday, October 30:

- **Dressing up in costume is optional.** Students who do not wear a costume can simply dress in their school uniform if that is their preference. **Those are the only two options on that day.** Students are not allowed to accessorize the school uniform or simply dress down for the day (e.g. **you will NOT be allowed** to wear jeans and a t-shirt to depict a public school student, etc.).
- **All dress code rules for dances (when we had them of course) also apply to Halloween (see below).**
- **Unlike previous years, (COVID) masks are allowed and even encouraged** as part of the costume. Since the students will be in class for much of the day, they will not be allowed to wear anything on their face except for make-up and Halloween-style covid masks. Hair coloring is permitted as well.
- **Absolutely no weapons** of any kind (fake or otherwise) will be permitted at school. Any such items brought to school will be confiscated and kept in the office until they can be picked up by a parent/legal guardian. Students who bring them will receive a consequence.
- **Keep in mind** when selecting a costume that **we are a Catholic community.** While it is not always easy, we seek to find a balance between not taking ourselves too seriously and having fun with

trying to manage what is and isn't appropriate for our school. **If you are not sure...ASK first!**

- **Finally, students are not allowed to bring any firecrackers or fireworks to school. Students who do so will face consequence that will include a suspension from school.**

Dress Code

Girls

- No spaghetti straps
- No visible bra straps
- No cleavage or midriffs showing
- No inappropriate printing on clothing (pictures and/or words)
- No halter tops or "backless" shirts
- Skirts – 4" rule still applies (regardless of leggings)
- Dresses with straps (straps must be at least 2 inches wide)
- Leggings – girls are expected to wear a top that completely covers their backside

Boys

- No tank tops or sleeveless shirts
- No inappropriate printing on clothing (pictures and/or words)

General Rule of Thumb: If you are not sure, don't wear it unless it has been approved by administration
