

**PROTOCOL FOR ADMISSION INTO NOTRE DAME REGIONAL  
SECONDARY (GRADE 9-12)**

The following items and procedures must accompany the school application:

- ❑ A copy of the final report card from the previous year and/or a copy of the most recent report card, depending on the date of application.
- ❑ A Letter of Reference from the previous school's administrator or counsellor.
- ❑ Application should include a list of all special services that Notre Dame needs to be aware of (e.g. medical forms, psycho-ed testing, modified course work, etc.)
- ❑ Prospective students may be subject to an interview with a panel of two or more people, one of which will be a school administrator.

**Notice to Parent/Guardian and prospective student(s)**

- ❑ Prior to an application being considered approved, a review may be made on the applying student by our School Liaison Officer.

**If accepted into Notre Dame Regional Secondary School the student will be subject to the following conditions:**

- The student will be placed on a one-year probation. All school policies and rules must be adhered to as indicated in the school agenda book.
- An academic and behavioral review will be conducted at various points during the year.
