

# RENFREW STREET UPGRADES

## Sewer and Street Improvements

**COMPLETION: FALL 2022**

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City is upgrading critical infrastructure and improving safety for all users along Renfrew Street from McGill Street to E 1st Avenue.

Work includes replacement of nearly 2000 metres of sewer with a separated and larger capacity system. The new sewer will have a life expectancy of 100 years to help serve this growing neighborhood while improving the system's seismic resiliency.

We are also coordinating street and safety improvements including pavement and sidewalk repairs, signal upgrades and new pedestrian and cyclist signals.

### SEWER RENEWAL

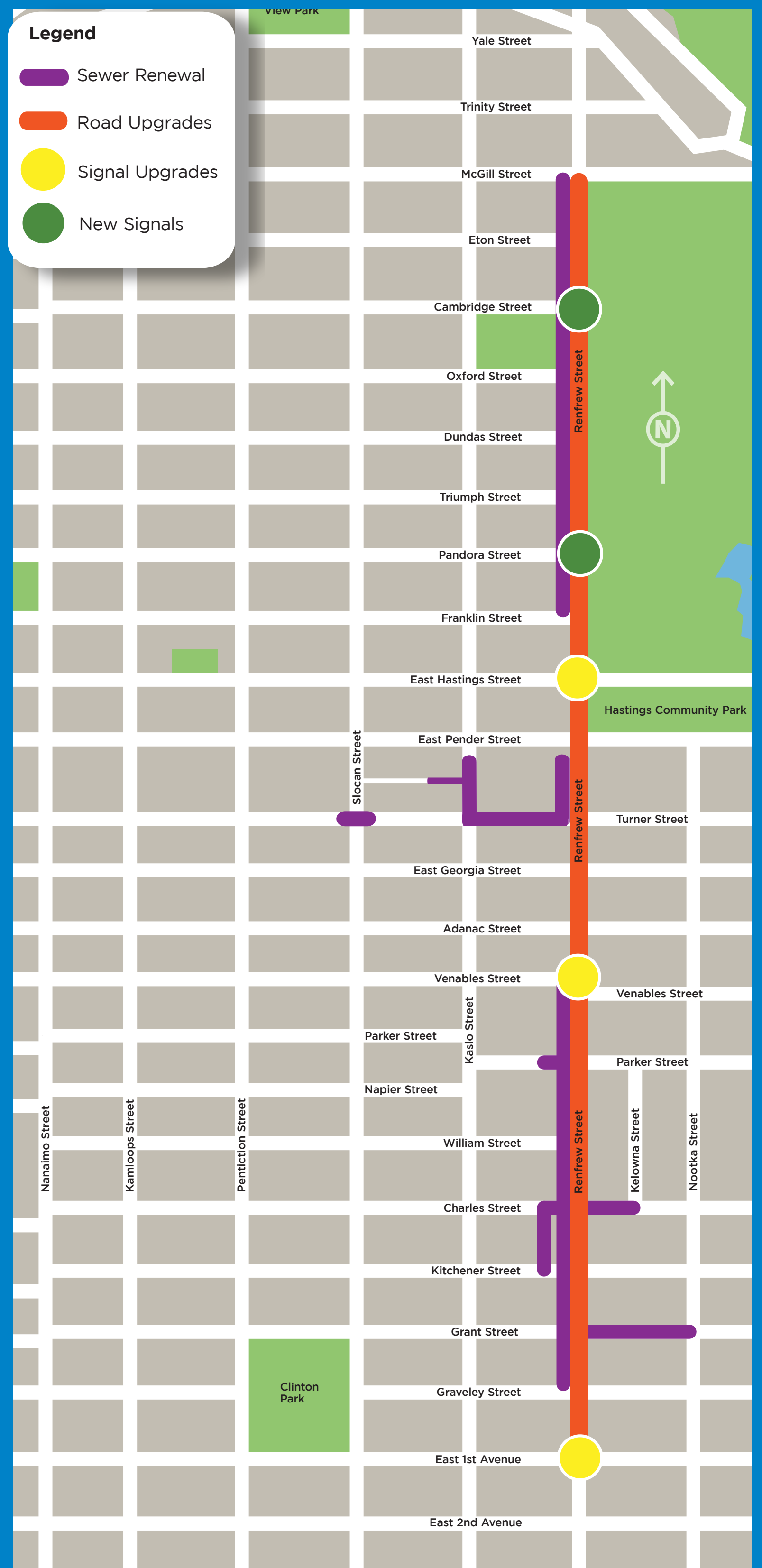
The existing combined sewer mains are at the end of their service life and the City is replacing them with a twin separated and larger-capacity system that will have a life expectancy of 100 years.

### TRANSPORTATION UPGRADES

We plan to use the necessary sewer upgrades as an opportunity to make the street safer and more comfortable for local residents, with a focus on priority sidewalk repairs, safer crossings and an improved pedestrian experience.

### CONSTRUCTION: WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work will generally take place Monday to Friday from 7 am to 5 pm
- Some extended work may be needed; weekdays up to 8 pm and on weekends
- Sidewalk access will be maintained during construction – please watch for detours and covered water hoses to ensure safety
- Parking and traffic restrictions will be in effect to accommodate construction
- Periods of noise, dust and vibration are expected
