

# Juggler Day

**The purpose of Juggler Days is to promote school spirit.** They are often combined with donations towards various charities. They are not intended to be a free-for-all in terms of what students can wear. It is always a challenge balancing a relaxed dress code opportunity with maintaining our identity as a Catholic school. **It is always a student's choice to participate or not.**

With that in mind, there will be limitations for all students regarding what is and what is not acceptable. The administration would like to offer these opportunities throughout each school year; however, for that to happen, students must be prepared to honour the dress code stipulations as listed below.

## Dress Code

**Please note that while we encourage ND tops and bottoms, students are only required to wear one or the other. If they choose "other" then they are expected to honour the following guidelines.**

### Tops

- Notre Dame sweaters, t-shirts (long or short-sleeved), golf shirts, jerseys, sweatshirts and jackets (including hoodies)
- If other tops are worn tops, they must be appropriate and school approved. Items that are not acceptable include: tank tops, muscle shirts, halter tops, tube tops, crop tops, tops with straps, etc.
- No hats or hoods (from hoodies)

### Bottoms

- Notre Dame sweatpants or other appropriate sweatpants
- Jeans (minimal holes or tears are permitted)
- No midriff showing
- No shorts (except ND shorts)
- **Bottoms such as leggings and yoga pants are permitted with the expectation that shirts or jackets completely cover the backside.**

### Shoes

- Dress shoes, runners, etc.
- **No open-toe sandals or flip-flops of any type are permitted**
  
- Any students who choose not to participate in Juggler Days are expected to be in full formal uniform.
- Any students who wear inappropriate or unapproved clothing items may be given a detention, lose the privilege of participating in future Juggler Days, and/or be sent home.
